He is a distinguished academic and educational leader whose career spans across teaching, pastoral ministry, and scholarly research. With a rich educational background including a Master of Arts, a Diploma in Education, and a Doctorate in Philosophy, David has dedicated his professional life to the exploration and dissemination of knowledge in the realms of Bible, Theology, and New Testament studies. David's journey at Morling began in 2005, where he commenced his tenure as a lecturer specializing in New Testament, Hermeneutics, Greek, and Theology.

David worked as an English teacher in Western Sydney before completing theological studies and serving as a pastor in Sydney's Inner West. He and his family currently attend Chatswood Baptist Church.
